Failure to deliver artwork for competition is considered a breach of ethics and will exclude artist from entry into future exhibits. No artwork may be substituted. The STAAA reserves the right to eliminate artwork if it is considered inappropriate, a reproduction and not the original work, not completed within the 3-year time frame, different from the CD image sent by the artist, or exhibited in a past STAAA exhibit.

Artwork Pick-up: Sun, May 27, 2-5pm

THE EXHIBIT & ARTWORK ELIGIBILITY

This exhibit is intended to explore nature in all of its beautiful forms and/or the wildlife that inhabits the great outdoors (i.e. landscapes, seascapes, floral, plant life, wild animals, marine life, birds, etc.) Artists may enter up to 3 original 2D or 3D pieces created within the past 3 years and NOT exhibited in previous STAAA exhibits. Entries must be THE original created piece of artwork, not a giclee or enhanced giclee of the original artwork, or a limited edition print (with the exception of photography and original printmaking), reproductions or enhanced reproductions of any kind. Works that reference hunting or taxidermy will not be eligible. Human elements shall not be present, except on the rare occasion where those human elements enhance the nature story. One piece of artwork per artist will be accepted into the exhibit.

ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS

2D, 60" x 60" max including frame; 3D, 5' x 3' x 3' max, freestanding or must fit on a pedestal, weighing no more than 50lbs unless preapproved and installed by the artist. Artwork must be fully assembled upon delivery. Accepted 2D work should be suitably framed and ready for hanging with picture wire. NO non-glare glass. Museum wrapped

pieces must either be framed or at least 2" in width with all edges finished. Photography must be matted and framed, with glass or plexi (if shipped), ready for hanging with picture wire only. Any form of manipulation that alters the truth of the photographic statement is ineligible.

JUDGES

A jury panel of award-winning artists, representing a variety of media, will rate the CD entries thus creating the exhibition. Awards will be judged "in person" once the show is installed. **Notification of Acceptance will be sent by Email.**

METHOD OF ENTRY & CD

Complete and sign this ENTRY FORM and mail with CD and payment to: The St Augustine Art Assoc., 22 Marine St., St Augustine, FL 32084. **CD OF ARTWORK IMAGES:** Images must be in jpeg format, high resolution (300 dpi). Low-resolution images will not be accepted. Write your name on the CD. "Save" each image with the following info: Name, Title, Media. Include only the images of entries photographed in front view, without frame or stand. Additional images on CD will disqualify the artist.

DELIVERY & PICK-UP OF WORK

Accepted artwork must be hand delivered to the St. Augustine Art Association Sun, Apr 22, 2-5pm or Mon, Apr 23, 12-4pm. **Pick-up:** Sun, May 27, 2-5pm. Works shall not be removed from the gallery before the end of the exhibit. Unclaimed art will incur a \$5/day storage fee.

SHIPPING & HANDLING

Shipped art must be delivered to the ST. AUGUSTINE ART ASSOC., 22 MARINE ST., ST. AUGUSTINE, FL 32084 by Wed, Apr 18. A Pre-paid Return Shipping Label AND separate \$40 handling check made payable to STAAA must be included with the package. NO packing peanuts are allowed. Works must be properly packed to avoid damage. Artwork will be returned in the original packing upon the close of the exhibit. No glass on shipped artwork.

SALES & REPRODUCTION

All artwork must be for sale. Sales will be handled by the STAAA, which will retain 40% of the selling price. The gallery reserves the right to reproduce accepted artwork for promotional purposes.
