St. Augustine Plein Air Paint Out

REGISTRATION GUIDELINES – Online or Mail

Must be 18 years or older.

Register & Pay Online (www.staaa.org/pleinair) or Mail/Email completed Registration Form and payment.

Application Deadline: Online: April 16, 2019. Mail/Email: Postmarked by April 11, 2019.

Registration Fee: \$59 (via PayPal, credit card or check made payable to St. Augustine Art Association).

Registration fee includes: Access to paint on approved private properties during the event; Access to the STAAA Wet Room; Discounted parking at approved lots; Social Gatherings & Enrichment Activities; Free entrance to select Attractions; Refreshments; Artist Materials & Souvenir Bag and more

FIRST CHECK IN & STAMPING

Early Check-in: Tuesday, April 23 from noon-4pm, prior to the Meet & Greet Reception.

- Check in IN PERSON at STAAA. (Water provided daily)
- All surfaces/canvases must be stamped upon initial Check In.
- A Paint Out ID Badge must be worn while working on location and event flags must be displayed at easels.

FIELD LOCATION VERIFICATION

Artists must notify STAAA of their field locations by calling/emailing (904) 824-2310 or info@staaa.org. A Location Log will be posted in the gallery. Artists may work in and around St. Augustine except prohibited areas. Artists must ask permission to paint on private property. Maps and suggested sites will be provided. Artists may not display or sell artwork or distribute personal promotional materials while in the field: One Artist/One Easel/One Canvas. No exceptions.

WET ROOM

Works-in-progress and finished works may be stored in the STAAA Wet Room.

Works may be sold from the Wet Room. STAAA will process all sales and will retain 30% for STAAA members and 40% for non-members.

JURIED EXHIBIT: “Where Art Meets History” – MAY 3-26, 2019, at the St. Augustine Art Association

- **ELIGIBILITY** Works produced during the Paint Out by registered artists will be eligible for the juried exhibit.
 - Artwork must be finished with a **frame** and wire for hanging. (No gallery wrapped canvas. White/Off white mattes only) Size may not exceed 48" (any side).
 - **LIMIT:** 3 entries. **FEE:** \$10/per piece for STAAA members and \$15/per piece for non-members. STAAA will process all sales and will retain 30% for members and 40% for non-members.
- **DELIVERY/RECEIVING:** Wednesday, May 1, noon – 6pm at STAAA, 22 Marine St., St. Augustine, FL 32084. (Early Deliveries may be processed by permission during the Paint Out.)
- **INSTALLATION/JUDGING:** Thursday, May 2, 2019
- **CLARK & ALICE ALGER AWARDS:** \$1000 Best in Show; \$750 First Place; \$500 Second Place; \$250 Third Place; additional sponsor awards. Judge's decision is final.
- **PATRON'S PREVIEW & AWARDS RECEPTION:** Friday, May 3, from 7 to 9pm
